19 people were murdered in terrorist attacks since the beginning of 2022, 11 of which were murdered by terrorists from the Jenin area.



Terrorist Attacks on the Israeli Home Front Carried Out by Terrorists From the Jenin Area in the Last Year



May 13th - Israel Border Police Officer, Command Sergeant Major Noam Raz Killed in Jenin



Killed during operational activity in the city of Jenin

September 4th - Shooting Attack Toward a Bus in the Area of the Jordan Valley Brigade

Terrorist Organizatons in Jenin

Data on Terrorist Organizations in Jenin and the Jenin Camp



Hamas

Approximately 250 operatives

150 of which operate within the camp



Islamic Jihad

Over 300 operatives **240 of which operate within the camp**



Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine (PFLP)

Approximately 50 operatives

30 of which operate within the camp





The Jenin Area is the Most Prominent in Terrorist Incidents

Since the beginning of 2022, more than 70 shooting attacks have been carried out toward Israeli security forces in Jenin, making up 80% of the shooting attacks toward Israeli security forces in Judea and Samaria.

Since the beginning of 2022, Israeli security forces carried out 79 counterterrorism activities in Jenin, during which more than 50 terrorist operatives were detained.

The majority of the camp's residents are of working age (15-44) 53% men and 47% women



The Jenin area holds 287 schools, 50 medical centers and hospitals, an academic campus, 300 mosques and 5 active churches.

The Main Challenges from Terrorists in the Jenin Camp

- Widespread violence against security forces, including precise fire toward soldiers, as well as the hurling of rocks, Molotov Cocktails, burning tires, explosives and more.
- Accelerated Islamic Jihad terrorist activity, using every opportunity to destabilize the area and strengthen terrorism.
- Presence of a wide range of weapons explosive devices, guns and more.

The Islamic Jihad in Jenin

Approximately 25% of the population in Jenin is affiliated with the Islamic Jihad terrorist organization. The leaders of the terrorist organization in the Gaza Strip and Syria invest great efforts to provide weapons, funding and military training for terrorist operatives in Jenin in general and in the camp in particular, in order to operate against the IDF and carry out terrorist attacks on the Israeli home front.

Hamas in Jenin

Approximately 20% of the population in Jenin is affiliated with the Hamas terrorist organization. The terrorist organization operates to strengthen terrorist infrastructure in Jenin, publicly praises terrorist attacks that originated in Jenin and incites further terrorist attacks by the residents of Jenin against the State of Israel.

As proven, the terrorist organizations attempt to 'set the West Bank ablaze' and view Jenin as an ideal opportunity for this activity.





Details of the Counterterrorism Activity During Which Ms. Shireen Abu Akleh Was Killed

Location of the Activity

Menashe Brigade, Jenin area, Jenin Camp, Al Jabari neighborhood.

Date

Wednesday, May 11th, 2022

Objective of the Activity

Apprehending two operatives from the Islamic Jihad and Hamas terrorist organizations.

Timeline

During the counterterrorism activity, Palestinian gunmen hurled explosives and shot at IDF soldiers. The soldiers responded with live fire toward the suspects.

Results of the Activity


One suspect was apprehended in the Al Jabari neighborhood and the second suspect was not detained, the journalist Shireen Abu Akleh was hit during the activity.
